Skagit Regional Health includes Skagit Valley Hospital, Cascade Valley Hospital and more than two dozen clinic locations in Skagit, Island and Snohomish counties in northwest Washington. This integrated healthcare system provides advanced, quality and comprehensive services to the people of our communities.

Skagit Valley Hospital in Mount Vernon, licensed for 137 beds, features a full range of services including comprehensive cancer care; surgical services; a Level III Emergency Department; a well-appointed Family Birth Center; comprehensive diagnostics; and advanced heart and vascular care.

Cascade Valley Hospital in Arlington, licensed for 48 beds, features an award-winning wound care center; free-standing surgery center; a level IV Emergency Department; and a wide array of diagnostic imaging services.

Skagit Regional Health includes a network of more than two dozen outpatient healthcare facilities providing primary and specialty care in north Snohomish, Island and Skagit counties. Patients move seamlessly through the entire continuum of health care, from primary and specialty outpatient services to inpatient acute care, with a top-tier electronic health record across the organization creating “one patient, one record” for all encounters across services.

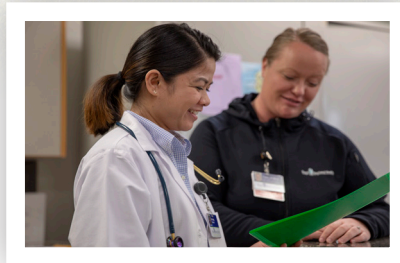
