## REGISTRATION

### NEED AN ACTIVATION CODE?

1. Visit [SkagitRegionalHealth.org/MyChart](http://SkagitRegionalHealth.org/MyChart) and click **Login/Sign up**.
2. Once in MyChart, click the **Sign Up** button.
3. On the right side of the page click **Sign Up Online**.
4. Fill out all demographic information, complete the CAPTCHA and click the **Submit** button.
5. In a few days you will receive an e-mail from MyChart@skagitregionalhealth.org. Click the **Sign Up for MyChart** button in this e-mail.
6. MyChart's Activation page will open with the activation code prefilled. Enter your last 4 of SSN, DOB and click the **Next** button.
7. Choose a username/password combination, a Security Question/Answer and click the **Next** button.
8. Choose your notification method (e-mail or text), verify e-mail address and/or mobile phone number and click the **Sign In** button.
9. Read the MyChart Terms & Conditions and click the **Accept** button.

**Now that you've signed up, download the app and access your health record – anytime, anywhere.**

After October 1, 2017, our previous patient portal will not be actively updated by providers and staff at Skagit Regional Health. All patient portal users are encouraged to enroll in MyChart, and take advantage of the new tools and functionality MyChart offers.
