Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Employee Giving Campaign?

An opportunity for Skagit Regional Health employees to support the work of the Skagit Valley Hospital Foundation (SVHF) through an annual giving campaign.

Why should I participate in the Employee Giving Campaign?

Gifts to the Employee Giving Campaign directly impact the quality of patient care and facility standards. Patient care services, health education and vital equipment purchases have been made possible by the support of our employee donors.

How much of my dollar actually goes to the Foundation fund I designate?

100% of your tax-deductible donation through the Employee Giving Campaign is directed to the Skagit Valley Hospital Foundation fund you designate.

How do payroll deductions work?

You may authorize a one-time donation, deducted from your June 20, 2019 paycheck or a monthly donation beginning with your June 20, 2019 paycheck and continuing for one full year.

How do donations of PTO (Paid Time Off) and PTO-PSL (Paid Sick Leave) work?

Indicate the number of hours you would like to donate in PTO or PSL hours. Payroll will calculate the dollar amount as your gift amount*. Please note, you can only donate PTO-PSL if after donation remaining balance is 40 hours of PTO-PSL.
